Maggie came to Interwork in early 2009. She suffered quite high Anxiety levels and Depression and found it difficult to do simple things such as the shopping or anything where there were crowds.

Maggie mentioned in one of the first interviews with EC Andrew that she had often thought about getting in to Youth Work and would like to maybe work with Young People under Govt care.

Maggie felt that she would be able to relate to kids in this sector as she had similar issues growing up.

Andrew managed to find a free PPP course through TAFE SA and with lots of support from Andrew.

Maggie commenced a Cert III in Community Service (Youth Work). Maggie attended this course continuously through 2009 and completed the Certificate later that year.

Interwork EC Andrew assisted client to apply for a Youth Work position in early 2010 and Maggie was successful in gaining this position.

Maggie has since gone on to study Cert IV in Youth Work with further assistance in her Post Placement stage of the Interwork program by Ongoing Support EC Samantha at Salisbury, and is close to completing this qualification.

Maggie has been working an average of 30-40 hrs per week since commencing in her Youth Work role and loves her job, and new found financial freedom. Well done Maggie!
