### Good News Story – CEDUNA

Toby and Darcy Sim are 24 year old twins who reside in Ceduna, SA.

Both have Cerebral Palsy, with Toby's upper body and Darcy's lower body being affected.

Although both boys are very popular in Ceduna and had undertaken sporadic work in the past, they had been unable to gain permanent employment even with support of their local JSA providers.

Interwork was approached by a Ceduna school official after being involved with other Interwork 'success stories' in their remote town. Although Toby and Darcy finished school several years ago, their family was known through the town and Interwork was encouraged to get in touch with them to offer a more tailored job search service.

Within 3 weeks, due to a very supportive community and the relentless efforts of the Port Lincoln BDO, full-time employment was secured at the same workplace for both Toby and Darcy. Interwork assisted with Wage Subsidies, the purchase of suitable work clothes, and the option of Work Place Modifications if they become necessary.

Highway One Motel and Service Station was more than happy to provide an opportunity as long as the Sim brothers were willing to work. Judging by the amount of hours being logged by both Toby and Darcy each week, they have proved their value to Highway One Manager Jo, who laughingly told the Port Lincoln BDO "...the boys have as much work as they can handle and more if they want it."

Their duties include console operators, stocking fridges, stocking shelves and customer service.
